

Ligonier Township Supervisors  
Minutes  
8 January 2013

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session with all three Supervisors present: Chairman Keith A Whipkey, Timothy R Komar, and newly-appointed Grover T Binkey. He will serve in 2013 in place of retired William C Penrod Jr.

From the audience, Scott Matson asked if the Township could clean up Kissell Springs Road. Komar responded that the Township will continue to maintain that road.

A motion was made by Komar and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 11 December regular meeting. Motion carried. Binkey abstained from the vote as he did not attend in official capacity.

A motion was made by Komar and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 18 December special meeting. Motion carried. Binkey abstained from the vote for the same reason.

A motion was made by Binkey and seconded by Komar to approve the minutes of the 7 January re-organization meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Komar and seconded by Binkey to approve the Treasurer's report for December. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Binkey and seconded by Komar to pay current bills. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Komar and seconded by Binkey to accept the Police Incident report for December. Motion carried.

1. A request was made by representatives of Coal Loaders Inc to continue the hearing scheduled this evening for Mellon #1 coal reclamation project as their attorney could not attend. 1. A motion was made by Komar and seconded by Binkey to approve Resolution 2013-R-03, a final settlement of the Dodson Conditional Use in Laughlintown, subject to withdrawal of legal action on behalf of Dodsons against the Township. Motion carried.

New business:

1. A motion was made by Komar and seconded by Binkey to accept the resignation of Dan Weimer from the Planning Commission as he is employed by the new Township Engineer. Motion carried.
