

Ligonier Township Supervisors  
Minutes  
9 March 2010

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session with all three Supervisors present: Chairman Timothy R Komar, William C Penrod Jr, and Keith A Whipkey.

There being no questions from the audience, a motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 9 February meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Komar to approve the Treasurer's report for February. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to table approving the listing of current bills as a computer malfunction resulted that the list was not available. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Whipkey to accept the Police Incident report for February. Motion carried.

Zoning Office – Cynthia J Turley

1. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to set a hearing date of 23 March, at 7 pm, to hear testimony regarding an application by Festival Fun Parks (aka Kennywood Park) for the locating of an ATT cell tower on Clark Hollow Road. Motion carried.

Old business:

1. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to approve Resolution 2010-R-05, authorizing the Chair or Vice Chair to act to effectuate the acquisition of property owned by Bernard and Sandra Harr for use by the Recreation Board for the hiking/biking trail. Associated costs will be borne by the Township. Motion carried.

New business:

1. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to set spring dumpster day as Saturday, 24 April 2010, from 8 am until noon at the current location on Old Lincoln Highway West
2. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to appoint Ron Dorazio as Assistant Emergency Management Coordinator for Ligonier Township. Motion carried.
3. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to accept the low bids for the current phase of the hiking/biking trail: Supancic Excavating \$8,480 for labor and \$8,350 for materials.
4. The Chairman announced that a list is being prepared for property owners wishing to sign up for dirt, fill, and wood chips for the summer. Contact the office.
5. Jim Roberts appeared to discuss the circumstances around a fire the destroyed his home.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to adjourn the meeting at 7:23 pm. Motion carried.
