Ligonier Township Supervisors Minutes 1 May 2012

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session (advertised change of date due to conflict of schedule with the State Association of Township Supervisors annual conference) with all three Supervisors present: Chairman Keith A Whipkey, Timothy R Komar, and William C Penrod Jr.

A number of individuals from the audience spoke in favor of passage by the Supervisors of a proposed resolution in support of efforts by other municipalities to have Act 13, related to the drilling of natural gas. Solicitor Judith Ciszek reported that she had some changes to make to the prototype resolution supplied by the citizens group. In addition, Supervisors desire to attend the State Conference to gain a better understanding of Act 13 before voting on this issue.
