The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session with all three Supervisors present: Chairman Keith A Whipkey, Timothy R Komar, and William C Penrod Jr.

As no one in the audience had non-agenda issues to discuss, a motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Komar to approve the minutes of the 12 June regular meeting. Motion carried.

3. As no one appeared to represent Bob Davis subdivision application, a motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Komar to grant a time waiver until the August meeting provided that the waiver be signed promptly by a representative. Otherwise, the application will be deemed denied. Motion carried.
