

Ligonier Township Supervisors
Special Meeting
10 July 2012

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in special session at 6:45 pm for the advertised purpose of obtaining public comment regarding proposed Ordinance 2012-OR-02, amending the Zoning Sign Ordinance to address civic/religious signs. Present were Chairman Keith A Whipkey, Timothy R Komar, and William C Penrod, Jr.

Solicitor Judith Cizek and Zoning Officer Cindy Turley explained that the current ordinance addressed political and real estate signs, but did not indicate her responsibilities regarding signs for community events sponsored by civic organizations or churches. Upon general agreement of the Supervisors, the scope of coverage expanded beyond only Township events to include also those Ligonier Borough activities with signs in the Township.

As no one appeared in support or opposition to the proposed ordinance, a motion was made by Komar and seconded by Penrod to close the comment period. Motion carried.

A motion was made to adjourn the hearing at 7:00 pm. Motion carried.
