

Ligonier Township Supervisors

Minutes

14 December 2010

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session at 7 pm with all three Supervisors present: Chairman Timothy R Komar, William C Penrod Jr, and Keith A Whipkey.

There being no comment from the audience, a motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 9 November meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 16 November special meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve the minutes of the 18 November special meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Komar to approve the Treasurer's report for November. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve payment of the current bills. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to accept the Police Incident report for November. Motion carried.

Zoning Office – Cynthia J Turley

1. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to table consideration of a subdivision for Mary Giesey on Matson Road pending receipt of a time waiver from the applicant. If the time waiver is not received, application is considered denied. Motion carried. Neighbor Lisle Conway was present to ask questions of the Township regarding a proposed right-of-way and the Township's responsibility for it. Solicitor Judith Cizek explained that the right-of-way will always be the responsibility of the private owners of the two applicable properties.
2. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to approve a subdivision request by Stephen Bridge on Clark Hollow Road. Motion carried.
3. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to table consideration of a subdivision for Robert Davis on Youngstown Ridge Road pending receipt of a time waiver from the applicant. If the time waiver is not received, application is considered denied. Motion carried.

Old business:

1. A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to discontinue a contract with the Westmoreland County Transit Authority, as the Authority makes no stops in the Township on its daily runs. The Township is not aware of any residents using the service. Motion carried.

New business:

1. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey approve Resolution 2010-R-14, waiving Police contributions to the Pension plan for 2011. The plan is overfunded. Motion carried.
2. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Whipkey to hire Robert A Shaw as an On-Call Police Officer effective 14 December 2010. Motion carried.
3. Supervisors announced that they will hold a special meeting at 8 am on Tuesday, 21 December for the purpose of adopting the final budget for 2011. No increase in taxes is being proposed.
4. A motion was made by Penrod and seconded by Komar to release the bond of Harold Eutsey on Christner Road. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Whipkey and seconded by Penrod to adjourn the meeting at 7:25 pm. Motion carried.
