You can enter your number or be removed from the list if you wish not to be contacted. We will only call when the situation becomes necessary.

East Sewage Project

The Authority will be starting the Ligonier East Sewage Project later this year. This will bring sewer lines along Route 30 from Ligonier to the new bridge on the Ligonier side of Laughlintown. This project includes Loyalhanna Cottages and Hi Acres. (The plans may change somewhat if we do not receive all the money expected.) Our men are currently contacting property owners to obtain right-of-ways. This project was a result of requirements from DEP and will have a positive impact on our local environment.

Blood Drive

The Township of Ligonier will be holding a blood drive at the Ligonier Township Municipal Building on Monday, September 13, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 6:00 p.m. The blood drive is being held through the Central Blood Bank. TAX COLLECTOR

Ligonier Township Fall taxes (school) will be mailed out on August 1, 2010. If you do not receive your statement, please contact the Ligonier Township Tax Office. Failure to receive a statement does not relieve the taxpayer of the responsibility of payment Taxpayers are responsible for sending the tax statement to the mortgage companies. The last day to pay your 1st school installment payment is September 30. 2nd installmant payment October 31; 3rd installment payment November 30 If you pay after these dates on your installment payment there will be a 10% penalty added. The last day to pay school taxes (fall) at discount is September 30. If paying by mail or through the door slot, make sure to enclose the statement and a self-addressed stamped envelope with the payment if you wish to receive a receipt. Ligonier Township Spring taxes (county and township) are at penalty until December 31, 2010. The tax office will be closed July 6, 7, and 8. An after hour drop-off slot is available to accept payments before or after normal business hours.

*Tires, vehicle batteries, freon appliances, and electronics are collected at separate Westmoreland Cleanways collection events. These items CAN NOT be accepted at the HHW collection. Disposal fees apply - cost of these events are NOT covered by HHW sponsorships.

**Dried latex paint in cans can be thrown in the trash. Dry latex paint at home by pouring it over an absorbent substance, such as a clay based cat litter. Once the liquid is absorbed, place in a plastic bag and dispose with your regular trash.

FLOOD MAPS ARE CHANGING...

What you should know

A multi-year project to re-examine flood zones and develop detailed, digital flood hazard maps is nearing completion. The new maps reflect current flood risks and areas of recent growth, replacing maps that are up to 13 years old. As a result, property owners throughout Ligonier Township will have up-todate, reliable. Internet-accessible information about their flood risk - on a property-to-property basis. And many owners will learn that their risk is higher, or lower, than they thought.

Flood Maps: A Risk Management Must

Flood hazard maps, also know as Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) are important tools in the effort to protect lives and properties in Ligonier Township. By showing the extent to which areas of Township and individual properties are at risk for flooding, flood maps help business and property owners make better financial decisions about protecting their property. These maps also allow community planners, local officials, engineers, builders and others to make important determinations about where and how new structures and developments should be built.

To ensure that everyone within Ligonier Township has access to the most accurate and up-to-date information about flood hazards, the new maps are being made available for public view and review. The maps are available for viewing during normal office hours at the Township Municipal Building.

Map Adoption Process

April 2010: Preliminary maps released

May 2010: Start of 90-day Public Comment Period (for filing of appeals and protests)

June 2010: County and federal review begins

March 2011*: Maps adopted; new insurance requirements take effect
