We all know that summer is here. I would like to bring your attention to some safety tips in reference to bicycle safety. Since it is summer, we are going to encounter more activity with bicyclists. This may be you, your kids or even another bicyclist just wanting to enjoy a ride on a nice summer day. Please keep in mind that bicycles are smaller and slower than motor vehicles. Cyclists need to be more alert than drivers. Don't assume that motorists or pedestrians see you. Cyclists need to communicate and negotiate with other vehicles. Using hand signals, making eye contact, smiling and waving (just to be courteous), all help keep the roads and trails safe for everyone. Please read the following list for some additional helpful biking tips and have a good and safe summer.

- 1. Wear a helmet
- 2. Follow the rules of the road
- 3. Obey traffic lights, signs, speed limits and lane markings
- 4. Cycle single file and on the right side of the road (with traffic)
- 5. Signal in advance of a turn; use correct hand signals
- 6. Yield to pedestrians and other vehicles

Ligonier Township Fall taxes (school) will be mailed on August 1, 2011, If you do not receive your tax statement, please contact the Tax Office. Failure to receive a statement does not relieve the taxpaver of the responsibility of payment. Tax payers who have mortgage companies, please mail your tax statement to your mortgage company as soon as possible for prompt payment. The last day to pay school taxes (fall) at discount is September 30, 2011. If paying by mail or through the door slot, make sure to enclose the statement and a self-addressed, stamped envelope with the payment if you wish to receive a receipt. Ligonier Township Spring taxes (county and township) are at Penalty until December 31, 2011. Tax Office will be closed July 4th through the 8th.

PennPRIME Peak Performer's Award

Ligonier Township is one of only 14 recipients of the PennPRIME Peak Performer's Award. PennPRIME is a member-driven, self-insurance trust that works with and is owned exclusively by Pennsylvania municipal entity members.

Each year PennPRIME recognizes members of the Workers' Compensation Trust with Peak Performer Awards for those entities that excel. The awards are granted based on 3 main criteria. The member must have a 5 year loss ratio (\$Losses/\$Contributions) of less than or equal to 30%, a functioning State-certified Safety Committee and must be a member of the Trust for 3 years. Additional criteria include annual self-assessments, providing safety training to all employees and developing written safety procedures.

Improved employee safety can translate into savings for the entity and the entire community. The employees who serve on the safety committee, leading the effort, deserve congratulations for their hard work.

The entities recognized for their outstanding workplace safety are: Berwick Borough, Derry Borough, East Stroudsburg Borough, Edinboro Borough, Ferguson Township, Findlay Township (Agh), the City of Greensburg, Ligonier Township, the City of Meadville, Northern Tier Solid Waste Authority, Punxsutawney Borough, the City of Titusville, Uwchlan Township and White Township.

The award winners are recognized at PennPRIME's Annual Membership Meeting and Risk Management Conference with a distinctive statuette. In addition, the recipients are also awarded a financial benefit of \$1,000 to be used to further improve employee safety.

Pipe Installation

The Ligonier Township Municipal Authority reports that the pipe installation for the Ligonier East Sanitary Sewer Collection project is approximately 87% complete. To date over 54,000 lineal feet of pipe has been installed, however progress has been slowed by the wet weather conditions this spring.

Restoration has begun and will continue as weather permits. It is anticipated that pipe installation will be complete in June of 2011.

Initial customer tap in notices will be sent after the pump station start up on June 15, 2011. The collection notices will be sent on a staggered basis to allow contractors time to complete installation of the individual connections. Installation specs and information will be provided upon payment of the connection fee to the Ligonier Township Municipal Authority. The connection fee has been established at \$1,500.00. This fee is payable within 60 days of notification by the Authority.


