Ligonier Township Supervisors Regular Meeting Minutes

April 13, 2021

The Supervisors of Ligonier Township met in regular session at 7:00 PM. Present were Chair, John Beaufort; Vice Chair, Paul Knupp; Secretary/Treasurer, Stephanie Verna; Supervisor, D. Scott Matson; and Supervisor, Dan Resenic.

Also present were Manager, Terry Carcella; Solicitor, Michael Korns; Engineer Ben Faas; Zoning Officer, Jim Nieusma, and Finance Officer, Bethany Caldwell.

Public Comment "A"

- 1. Melissa Eller provided an update on pool group's progress. The group has been busy researching permits, insurance, ADA compliance, wells, pumps, etc. They developed a budget based on several local pools and have applied for a non-profit status, purchased a website domain, met with contractors, and are looking at natural pool options. They have a meeting scheduled next Thursday at the Fort with a grant writer to discuss a feasibility study with Bionova, a company based in New Jersey that works with natural pools. They are looking at a 4-seasons park that would provide a positive economic impact to the community while not duplicating anything already in the Valley.
 - A motion was made by Stephanie Verna and seconded by Dan Resenic to approve the minutes from the March 23, 2021 meeting. Motion carried.

Manager's Report

Mr. Carcella gave an update on the American Rescue Plan – anticipate \$630k is coming to the Township, receiving half the funds in 2021 and half in 2022, and all funds to be spent by December 31, 2024 or returned. He noted 34 residents have signed up for Dumpster Day (April 24). Attended a "Text My Government" presentation, this service costs more than Savvy Citizen, but provides 2-way communication (as opposed to Savvy's 1-way). The Supervisors requested a demonstration.

Engineers Report

Received Quaker Sales Corp. contract.

Oakwood Hills Stormwater Review – met with Public Works staff at 107 West View Drive. Catch basins are installed, but the water originating from Oak View Drive above bypasses it due to lack of channeling and the water ends up in the resident's backyard.

The materials may be failing. May need to grade the roads. Homeowner has damage to their foundation / basement. RFP for curbing.

Solicitor's Report:

Mr. Korns reported that an executive session was held at prior to the public meeting and certified compliance with the Pennsylvania Sunshine Laws as the discussions pertained to personnel and property matters.

Public Works Report

Mr. Carcella reported the crew is sweeping roads - 75 roads have been swept, 41 to be completed. The Mac truck clutch has been repaired, the cost was \$6k.

Zoning & Code Report

Mr. Nieusma went over his monthly report – increase in lien request letters indicate it is a seller's market.

Price Land Development – side lot addition, approved by the Planning Commission

Graham Plan 2 Subdivision

 A motion was made by Scott Matson and seconded by Paul Knupp to approve the Graham Plan 2 subdivision. Motion carried.

 A motion was made by Scott Matson and seconded by Paul Knupp to approve the Tibbott Plan subdivision. Motion carried.

Meghan Freidhof covered Wessel's Financial Executive Summary from the 2020 audit.

New Business:

 Ligonier Beach Feasibility Study (Natural Swim Pool Concept) - hire a consultant to interview the foundations to do a financial feasibility study, study not to cost more than \$5k.

Supervisor Beaufort requested an additional meeting be set up with 2 Supervisors, 2 residents from pool community group, 2 members from the Rec Board to interview the consultant and go over the scope of work.

2. Janitorial Services RFP (Part time position)
Put cleaning services out to bid –

- 4. Municibid Auction Items (accept or reject bids) \$46 on lock boxes, \$150 for microphones, no bids on the telephones
 - A motion was made by Stephanie Verna and seconded by Scott Matson to accept the bids. Motion carried.
- 5. Mowing quotes 2 quotes were received
 - A motion was made by Paul Knupp and seconded by Dan Resenic to accept the low quote (Valley Landscaping). Motion carried.

Supervisor Knupp – Thanked staff.

Supervisor Verna – 1) Dumpster Day reminder is April 24, please call by April 20th deadline to register, 2) if residents would like information about the spotted lantern fly pest please call the Township, and 3) is not in favor of Text me Gov program – would like to get back to more traditional avenues of doing business.

Supervisor Resenic – requested an executive session to discuss a personnel matter

Supervisor Beaufort – said the fire companies would like to remind residents not to burn during high winds.


